Dear Children and parents/carers of **Year 1 Group B**

Coming back to school in June

When you come back to school on Monday 15th June (8th June for Key Workers' children) it will seem a little different. The adults in your group will be **Miss Richardson and Mrs Brown.**

You will come to school between **9am and 9.10am** and will be dropped off at the **Year 1 and 2 cloakroom door.** You will be picked up by your grown up at **3pm-3.10pm** from the same place. Please try to stick to these times as closely as possible. (If your grown up is a keyworker they can drop you off between 8.40am and 8.50am and pick you up at 3.30pm-3.40pm, in the same place as above if needed).

When you come into school with your grown up you can come through the gate on Tranby Lane or the back gate by the pond and then your grown up can leave by the gate next to the Astroturf or the gate at the back of the school by the pond (we will be opening the vehicle gate for wider access). We have put a one-way system in place to help everyone to keep a 2 metre distance.

When you get in to school our first job will be to wash our hands. We will do this in the classroom sink. We will remember to do this with soap and warm water and will do it for 20 seconds .

There will be only a small amount of children in your group. You will be able to play with these children but we will remind you to try to not touch or hug each other. There are lots of games you can play with your group which we will help you to think of.

We will be having our lunch in the classroom. You can either bring your own packed lunch or have a packed lunch made by the school cooks. We will have lots of playtimes but you will only be able to play with the children in your group. You might see children from other groups but it is important that we keep in our own groups. These groups will be called Bubbles.

Before you come to school you will need to have sun cream on and bring a sunhat and a coat; we will be going outside in all weathers. You can bring a small pencil case with a pencil, rubber, pencil sharpener and some crayons if you wish. This will mean you can have your own equipment that you don't need to share. You will need to leave this at school. If you are unable to bring this we will provide equipment you can use. The only thing you will need to bring to school other than this is your water bottle which you will take home each night to be cleaned. **Please don't bring any bags apart from your packed lunch.**

Sometimes the grown-ups in your group might wear a mask or gloves, but don't worry about this, this is just to keep everyone safe.

You might feel a little worried on the first day that you come back to school. That is normal but we are all here to help you enjoy your time back at school.
