Year 4 Visit to London – Class 4KC – Friday 7th June 2019



We are very much looking forward to our trip to London when, as well as our Houses of Parliament Tour and Workshop, we will also be taking the children on the London Eye! For your information, we have outlined the travel arrangements below:

The children will be travelling to London by train from Brough Station.

The children will need to be at the station by 6.20 am at the latest and should meet on the platform where the class teacher will take a register (the train departs at 6.38 am).

The children will return in the evening to Brough station and should be collected from there at 6.04 pm. NB All children will be taken off the train at Brough for collection by parents.

On the day of the trip the children will be required:

- to wear school uniform as usual;
- to wear sensible, comfortable, clean trainers or shoes;
- to wear a warm waterproof coat with hood or hat;
- to have had breakfast before we leave;
- to take a packed lunch and snacks for mid-morning and mid-afternoon;
- to take plenty of **drinks** (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please).

Children may take small items such as playing cards, a magazine or a book for the train. **No** electronic games, cameras, money or valuables please (staff will take cameras). Please would you put all items in a rucksack, which your child can carry hands-free on their back. **NB** There is no need to take money as there will be no opportunity to spend it!

The children will be put into small groups of 4 or 5 per adult and will be closely supervised at all times. The children will be issued with high-visibility vests to wear over their coats.

If your child requires an inhaler, please remember to pack it in their rucksack. Please ensure that travel sickness tablets have been taken before they travel and that your child has some to take for the return journey.
