Dear Parent/Carer

We are looking forward to seeing the Year 7 pupils on Monday 7th September for their end of school celebration! We have arranged this so that we can provide a send-off that we were unable to provide before breaking up for the summer holidays. The children will be kept together as a Year 7 bubble, in line with provision at the local secondary schools.

Below are the details of what you need to know:

8.40-8.50 am - Arrive at school and the children will come straight into their old Year 6 classroom.

9.15-11.45 am - Class and Year Group Challenges - We have arranged a quiz and some challenges and fun games that the children would usually enjoy in the last half-term of school. Where possible these will take place outdoors but if the weather does not permit, we will use the school halls.

The children will also have the chance to get their shirts signed. Please send your child with a shirt/t-shirt to be signed that they are NOT wearing, together with pens, in order to maintain social distancing.

11.45 am - Picnic Lunch (outdoors if possible). Packed lunches will be provided for those who have ordered them only, otherwise, children should bring their own packed lunch.

1.00 pm - We have organised for a photographer to take Year 6 class photos. These will be done in class groups, outdoors if possible. The photographer can also take small group photos. If you wish for your child to have a small group photo with their friends, please send a note to their teacher with the names of those they wish to have in the photo. We ask that the Year 6 children wear dark trousers and come with either their leaver's hoody or another navy sweatshirt for photograph purposes, please.

2.00 pm - We will hold the full Year 6 group presentations and Leavers' Assembly. We will be filming this for parents as we are unable to invite you to attend. We will send you a Microsoft Teams link, during the morning of Monday 7th September, that you will be able to use to view the live presentations.

We will send a recording after the event for those who are not able to watch live. We hope to be able to start this promptly at 2.00 pm but this is dependent on the photographs being finished on time. We anticipate that this will take approximately one hour.

3.15 pm - The children will leave the school site.

We hope that the plans that have been put in place will go some way to helping to ease any concerns that you have.
