We will be using the 'Swiggle' website to help us with our history and geography research.

CLIC – We will all do daily CLIC (arithmetic) sessions for 20 minutes. **Maths-** EYFS – Composition of numbers 6-10, 2D shapes, number bonds to 10. **Y1-** Number bonds to 20, Addition and subtraction using numbers to 20, Place value to 50, Measurement: Length and height, weight and volume.

Art – We will look in detail at the artist 'L.S. Lowry' and have a go at our own pictures of buildings in the style of his Art. We will continue to practice our colour mixing skills and explore with a range of materials.

Music- Listening to and appreciating various genres of music. Using percussion instruments. Learning Easter Songs.

PE-

There will be PE sessions on Tuesday and Thursdays. Children will develop their movement skills through dance, basic movement circuits and ball games.

History – We will look at a range of old buildings both locally as well as famous ones and think about the people who lived in these houses. We will consider how buildings have changed and learn about the materials that were available at the time. We will be asking and answering historical questions.

Geography- We will look at buildings that exist in both hot and cold countries and why they are made using certain materials. We will learn about human and physical features in our environment. We will also have a go at drawing simple maps of our bedrooms and of School using a key.

Science- Learning about different materials and how they are used in the environment. Brick, glass, wood, plastic, rubber, ceramics.

We will look at the different materials in detail and explore their properties for ourselves! We will also discuss how plastic is affecting our world.
