Class 4 – Visit to Eden Camp Museum, Malton, North Yorkshire. Tuesday 27th November 2018

On Tuesday 27th November the children in Class 4 will be visiting the above museum as part of this term's history topic.

The coach will leave school at approximately 9.00am and we aim to return to school for the end of the day, depending on the traffic. A text will be sent on the day should the coach be delayed.

A packed lunch and a drink of water are required (no glass bottles please). Would you please pack your child's lunch in a disposable bag so this can be thrown away afterwards. Please make sure your child has suitable warm outdoor clothing, normal uniform is to be worn.

A voluntary contribution of £12.00 per child to help cover the cost would be gratefully received. The trip is also being subsidised with Class 4 fundraising monies.

This visit is now available on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way. As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the school office.

As I am sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay.
