Re: Jamie Loncaster Memorial Fund

Jenny, Ross and I would like to extend our thanks to all the parents, pupils and staff who generously donated money to the **Jamie Loncaster Memorial Fund**, when Livi Taylor and her friends kindly sold wristbands and pop-i toys on our behalf.

You donated a staggering £517.50...! Thank you.

Jamie was a wonderful son and brother and we all miss him greatly. The love and support shown to us since his death has been truly overwhelming and we are now focusing on spreading awareness of the charity **Cardiac Risk in the Young** (www.c-r-y.org.uk) and the shocking statistics of young heart related deaths, which research by C-R-Y shows to be **at least 12 per week**. A staggering **80% have no prior symptoms** and neither did Jamie.

All money raised for the Jamie Loncaster Memorial Fund (*administered by Cardiac Risk in the Young*) is ring-fenced, so that we have control over how the money is used (within C-R-Y guidelines).

Our aim is to use the fund to offer free heart screening sessions for **local young people** (aged 14-35). These sessions cost around £3,500 per day and can screen 100 young people.

With donations to date, we have already scheduled a two day screening session to be held locally in mid-2016. Further details will be released early in 2016. Our ultimate goal is to raise enough money to screen a total of at least 1000 local young people – giving us an overall target of around £40,000.
