THE URBAN MERMAID CREATIVE WORKSHOP

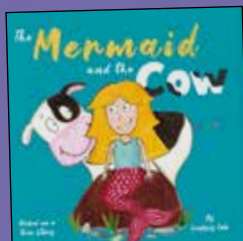

THE MAGIC FLUTE - FAMILY OPERA PERFORMANCES

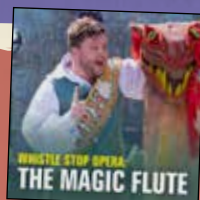
Join Prince Tamino on his quest to save the climate before it's too late!

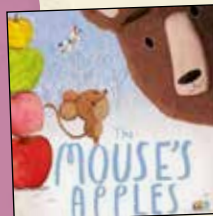
