Dear parents and carers,

Due to the number of COVID 19 cases in Class 2, it is necessary for extra precautions in school to be taken from now until the 11th October. Key Stage One (Class 1 and 2) will become one bubble due to the mixed teaching which they regularly undertake.

Start and Finish Times

As usual, Key Stage One children should line up at the front of the school from 8.50am. Please try not to arrive earlier and try to avoid your children mixing with any children in Key Stage Two. Key Stage One children will finish as usual at 3.30pm and are asked to leave the playground as soon as they have left school. If they have a sibling in Class 4, they should leave at 3.25pm.

Break times

Key Stage One will continue to have separate break times which include the lunch break. Children are already seated separately at lunch time and this will continue.

Face Masks

Staff will once again be asked to wear face masks in communal areas at school and when speaking with parents.

After school clubs

Where possible, after school clubs will take place either outside or in the Sports Hall so that children can be kept separate. If this is not possible, we will contact you separately to advise that your child may not be able to attend temporarily.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause but in other schools it has been found that if the bubble system was not implemented quickly the number of cases have risen very sharply. Hopefully, these small steps will help to reduce the transmission of COVID 19.
