Dear Children and parents/carers of **Key Workers**

Being in school from 8th June

We have an increasing number of Key Worker children returning to school. If you are able to keep your child at home, please try to do so that we can keep the school as safe as possible, with social distancing in place. If you do not sign up the week before you wish to send your child back, it is likely that we will not be able to accept your child in to school.

When you come back to school on Monday 8th June it will seem a little different. You will be in a 'Bubble' with children from your own year group. For children in Year 1 and Reception, you should have received letters via email earlier today.

Children in Year 2, you will be in the 4KC classroom with Miss Welbourne, Mrs Yu and Mrs Firth.

Year 3, you will be in the 3SP classroom with Mrs Patrick, Mrs Lee and Mrs Martin.

Year 4, you will be in 4MR classroom with Mrs Anderson, Mrs Ellis and Mrs Goulding.

Year 5 and 6, you will be in 5 RC classroom with Mrs McCallum, Mrs Lamb and Miss Shirley.

You can come to school at the usual time between 8.40am and 8.50am and pick up from the big playground at 3.30pm. Please try to stick to these times as closely as possible. Year 2-4 should come through the Year 3/4 cloakroom door on the big playground and Year 5 and 6 should enter through the mobile classroom doors.

When you come into school with your grown up you can come through the gate on Tranby Lane or the back gate by the pond and then your grown up can leave by the gate next to the AstroTurf or the gate at the back of the school by the pond (we will be opening the wider gate for wider access at the back of school). We have put a one-way system in place to help everyone to keep a 2 metre distance. The carpark will no longer be accessible for drop-off for parents as there are a larger number of staff returning to school. Children in Year 3 to 6 may take advantage of the 'drop-off' on Tranby Lane and walk into school via the pedestrian gate furthest away from Kemp Rd (not the one next to the astro turf). We would prefer that all children are collected from the playground at the end of the day.

When you get in to school our first job will be to wash our hands. We will do this in the classroom sink. We will remember to do this with soap and warm water and will do it for 20 seconds.

There will be only a small number of children in your group. You will be able to play with these children but we will remind you to try to not touch or hug each other. There are lots of games you can play with your group which we will help you to think of.

We will be having our lunch in the classroom. You can either bring your own packed lunch or have a packed lunch made by the school cooks. We will have lots of playtimes but you will only be able to play with the children in your group. You might see children from other groups but it is important that we keep in our own groups. These groups will be called Bubbles.

Before you come to school you will need to have sun cream on and bring a sunhat and a coat; we will be going outside in all weathers. You can bring a small pencil case with a pencil, rubber, pencil sharpener and some crayons if you wish. This will mean you can have your own equipment that you don't need to share. You will need to leave this at school. If you are unable to bring this we will provide equipment you can use. The only thing you will need to bring to school other than this is your water bottle which you will take home each night to be cleaned. Please don't bring any bags apart from your packed lunch.

Sometimes the grown-ups in your group might wear a mask or gloves, but don't worry about this, this is just to keep everyone safe.
