Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that we have received confirmation that a member of your child's year 4 group bubble has tested positive for **COVID-19**.

They presented no symptoms whilst attending school, but in line with Public Health guidance have now entered isolation.

In line with government guidance, your child should now self-isolate for 14 days. Other household members do not need to self-isolate unless your child starts to display symptoms:

Where the child, young person or staff member tests positive, the rest of their class or group within their childcare or education setting should be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 14 days. The other household members of that wider class or group do not need to self-isolate unless the child, young person or staff member they live with in that group subsequently develops symptoms.

Should your child begin to show symptoms of **COVID-19**, such as a high fever or new, persistent cough, they are eligible for testing. Please contact the **NHS**, either by calling 111 or visiting the website at 111.nhs.uk to arrange this if necessary.

I can assure you that the school are vigilant in following government and local authority guidance, including, but not limited to, a robust cleaning regime.

The school remains open to other children eligible for childcare.
