Dear parents and carers of children in years 2, 3, 4 and 5,

As you are aware, the school had to prioritise the return of Reception, year 1 and year 6 which we have managed to do and due to the size of the school and the number of keyworker children, we are unable to invite any further year groups back for a significant amount of time.

We have however arranged to invite the above year groups back for half a day to spend with their new class teacher. This will take place on Friday 10th July when the school is closed to all but key worker children. As we can only have a limited number of children in a group at a time, we will only be able to offer a half-day session. Before I can finalise the set up later in the week, I need to gauge an idea of the number of children who would be interested in returning for a half day. Please could you complete the following link by Thursday 2nd July at 12 noon after which I can provide further details of how the day will work.
