English

Fiction: Ug

Non Fiction: letter writing, explanation texts linking to volcanoes and newspaper texts also linking to volcanoes

Weather: Pupils will be able understand and speak simple phrases to describe the weather and learn how to talk about the weather in different countries around the world.

Science

Rocks and soils

We will compare and group together different kinds of rocks and soils and explore how fossils are formed.

Geography

We will use maps to locate countries in the northern and southern hemispheres (linking to volcanoes). We will also explore the layers of the earth through our work on volcanoes and how they are formed.

Computing

We will use search engines and key words to safely to research volcanoes and Stonehenge this term.

'Bucket filling and Bucket dipping!' Using our book 'Have you filled your bucket today?' we will promote a positive mindset to promote friendships and wellbeing throughout this term.

Art/DT

Children will create some 'dragon eye' artwork, using watercolour paint, to link in with the theatre company production. We will also create some fabulous cave art work using charcoal.

Music

Reggae music. We will focus on '3 little birds' by Bob Marley. Children will listen and respond to music, finding the pulse and evaluating the structure of the music and the instruments used. We will also enjoy the Queen classic 'We Will Rock You' as part of our topic work!
