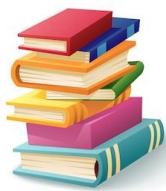

Owing to the retirement of our Cook and subsequent internal promotions, a vacancy has arisen for a temporary Catering Assistant to help with the day-to-day running and operation of our school kitchen; the position is both busy and varied. This post is available for six months in the first instance, although it may become permanent.

Hours of work: 15.25 hours per week as follows: Mon and Fri – 10.15 am to 1.45 pm (3 hours 30 mins per day) and Tues, Weds and Thurs – 11.00 am to 1.45 pm (2 hours 45 mins per day)


