REMINDER – Drop-Off and Pick-Up Arrangements

We should be grateful if adults and children of secondary school age, entering the school site during pick-up and drop-off times, would wear a facemask unless medically exempt. **We also ask that only one adult per family comes onto the school site at pick-up and drop-off times to avoid crowding.**

We should also like to remind adults to only attend at their child's class' allocated finish time and to leave the site as soon as possible after collection. **We would also ask, where possible, that Year 5 parents arrange to meet their child(ren) either on the big playground or just outside the school site.**

Please note, if your child is arriving after their designated start time (8.45–8.55 am or 9.00–9.10 am) they must enter through the main reception entrance on Tranby Lane so that they are included in the register.
