Absence and Late Arrival Reporting

Please note, if your child is arriving after their designated start time (8.45–8.55 am or 9.00–9.10 am) they should not enter the School via the playground doors. The child must enter through the main reception so that they are included in the register.

In order that School may follow national safeguarding guidelines, please see below how you should proceed when your child is either absent or late.

- A telephone call to the School's absence line 01482 631300, dial 1 and leave a message before 9.15 am on the morning of each day's absence.
- If a telephone call is not received and a child is absent without the School's prior knowledge, the School will telephone the parent/carer/other contacts asking for confirmation of the child's absence. By operating this system, we aim to ensure that children who have left home have arrived safely in School.
