### Sports Days 2021 - UPDATE

We are pleased to confirm that latest government guidance advises that Sports Days can go ahead!

In line with the rest of the system of controls in school, pupils must remain in their bubbles throughout.

We are still hoping to be able to invite parents to these events with stringent measures in place, however we may receive further information from the East Riding advising that this may not be possible. With that in mind, we have put plans in place for this to go ahead but may need to cancel.

Spectators must adhere to current social distancing requirements and, therefore, we request [you complete this link](#) if you wish to attend, in order to be allocated a seating area. Places will be allocated on a first come-first-served basis from the date/time you submit your form. This form will close 9am on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> June. Nearer the time, you will be sent information on your allocated seating area. Unfortunately, you will not be allowed entry onto the field unless you have an allocated place. Please note that only two people per family should attend each event (toddlers count as a place). Should you wish to attend more than one Sports Day, a separate form must be completed for each event.

On the day, entry to the field will be via the back gate (from the pond), there will be no toilet facilities nor refreshments available to spectators. The viewing area will be painted with white squares, one allocated per family, and you must remain in your square throughout the event and observe social distancing. If anyone is not adhering to these control measures, they will be asked to leave. Please bring your own chairs or blanket, as these will not be provided and we will be asking everyone to remain seated throughout the event.

Each event will start at 2.00 pm and gates will open at 1.30 pm (please **DO NOT** arrive before 1.30 pm to avoid congregating outside the gate). As seating areas for each family will be allocated before the day of the event, please do not turn up early to get the best seat.

Thank you in advance for your co-operation with these **COVID** controls. If for any reason the event has to be cancelled, for example because of bad weather or further guidance from the local authority, we will let you know as soon as possible.
