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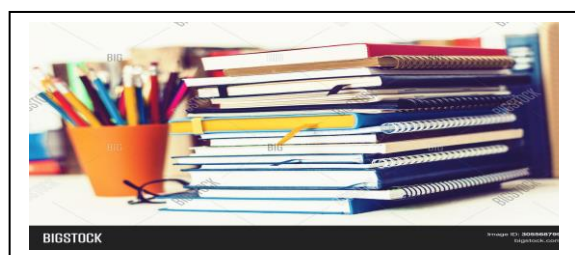

Home to school learning



School work continues to be placed on the school website for all classes. If you have any questions about home learning, please contact your child's class teacher on Seesaw or Tapestry.

Drop off and pick up times

In order to support social distancing, it is important that we adhere closely to the drop off and pick up times below. Children should enter through the middle black gates labelled 'Entrance' and line up outside the front of the school. Parents should then leave by the usual gate. Parents should then line up at the front at collection time.

EYFS	8.55-9.00	3.00pm
Year 1	9.05-9.10am	3.10pm
Year 6	9.15-9.20am	3.20pm

If you have children in two separate groups, you still need to adhere to the drop off and collections times for the group which they are in.

School reports

For children not in school, reports will be printed out and available to collect from school or they can be passed on to children who are in the following week. 
Parent Pay
