

Please find below guidelines for costumes:

Townsfolk and Main Characters

Boys (including girls playing the part of a boy):

Jeans, shirt (checked or plaid), neckerchief, optional waistcoat, cowboy hat, cowboy boots (or sandshoes), holster with toy gun (if possible).

Girls:

As for the boys or long, full skirt, pretty blouse, sandshoes, cowboy hat (which fits well enough to dance in!).

Cacti/Wasps

Green/brown T-shirt (or a mixture of natural colours), dark coloured trousers or leggings.

Please could your child's costume be brought into school on <u>Monday 28th January 2019</u> in a named carrier bag. Thank you.
