Year 5 Provisional Residential Visit to Robinwood Activity Centre, Todmorden
Wednesday 12th May to Friday 14th May 2021 – Deposit to Pay: £30.00

It is with pleasure that we are able to write with information regarding the above exciting visit, which will hopefully take place from 12th to 14th May 2021. To secure your child's place a non-refundable deposit of £30 per child should be paid by Friday 15th January 2021. The final cost is yet to be confirmed, but as a guide the visit cost was £248.98 last year.

The deposit for this visit is now on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way by Friday 15th January 2021 at the very latest. As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the School Office.

From the end of January 2021, once final numbers are confirmed, the balance will be available to pay on ParentPay and may be paid in instalments up until the final payment deadline of Wednesday 3rd March 2021.

We understand, at this time, that you may have questions concerning COVID-19 guidance.

The final cost will be determined by the number of children wishing to attend (deposits received) along with COVID-19 restrictions, ie whether we will need to use two coaches to ensure social distancing between class bubbles, which may increase the cost of the trip from last year.

If you have any questions about this trip, please do not hesitate to contact the Year 5 class teachers. If you decide you do not want your child to take part in this visit, they will attend school as normal. Of course, if government guidance dictates or numbers are too low, we may have to cancel. If the trip has to be cancelled due to COVID-19 you will be fully reimbursed, however, if you cancel yourself there will be no reimbursement.

As we are sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of his or her inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
