Year 2 – Everyday Materials Science Visit from the Scrapstore Team – Wednesday 17th November 2021

The Scrapstore team will be visiting school on Wednesday 17th November to complete some exciting activities with the two Year Two classes based around our current Science topic of ‘Everyday Materials’.

This is part of our Science topic and looks at the following objectives – identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses. We are also finding out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Each class will spend two hours exploring and building with a variety of materials in the school hall with two professional artists. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to investigate different materials in a fun and creative way. The work that the children will produce on the day will link to their Polar Regions topic. The children will have the opportunity to take part in creating a whole class sculpture and an individual model.

A voluntary contribution of **£6.06 per child** to help cover the cost of the day would be gratefully received.
