Year 6 Residential Visit to Haworth – Tuesday 25th June to Friday 28th June 2019
£50.00 Deposit to Secure a Place (by Friday 26th October 2018)

Following our Year 6 Meet and Greet meeting, it is with pleasure that we are able to write with information regarding the above exciting visit.

We will be staying at the stunning YHA Haworth in Keighley, West Yorkshire. YHA Haworth is a Victorian Gothic Mansion that was built as the family home of a local mill owner. Inside the building the sweeping staircase, ornate painted glass, richly carved oak and plaster friezes hint at the building's opulent past.

Here are just some of the exciting activities which we hope to include in this residential visit:

- Doe Park Reservoir – High ropes, sit on top boats, dragon boating, raft building
- RMJ Falconry
- Bronte Parsonage
- Stump Cross Caverns
- Malham Cove
- Eureka

We are very aware of the frustrations of some families that the date of this visit has clashed with South Hunsley's transition day. Please understand that we are also frustrated that we have found ourselves in this situation and it was never the intention to knowingly cause this. We know that a message has already been put out to parents explaining how the booking process works and consequently the difficulties that we are faced with when trying to re-arrange such a visit.

Should you like your child to participate in this residential visit, we would ask for a **non-refundable deposit of £50** to secure your child's place. The deposit is now showing on ParentPay and should be paid by **Friday 26th October 2018**.

Numbers will have to be confirmed with the coach company and each of the attractions concerned, therefore, we will be unable to make changes to numbers after the deposit deadline.

The final cost is yet to be confirmed, but as a guide we anticipate this to be **around £280**. The price will include transport, all meals and all activities.

As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the school office.


