Dear Parent/Carer (Year 6)

Year 6 – Visit to ‘Allerthorpe Lakeland Park’ in Allerthorpe, Pocklington – Friday 18th June 2021

Year 6 are planning to visit ‘Allerthorpe Lakeland Park’ in Allerthorpe for a day of water-based activities on Friday 18th June. The day’s activities will include: the ‘Run of Kit’ activity (use of single kayaks, double kayaks, stand up paddle boards, pedalos and canoes) and the ‘Aqua Park’ activity (an inflatable obstacle course on the lake that includes a variety of challenging elements for participants to enjoy with Thunderdome and Gravity Corners!). The two classes will swap activities after lunch.

The children will be leaving school directly after registration at 8.45 am and will travel by coach to ‘Allerthorpe Lakeland Park’. Specific clothing is required for the two activities – please see the attached Kit List. Please send your child prepared for the ‘Kayaks’ and ‘Aqua Park’ activities with **two** towels, their swimsuit on under their clothes and their underwear **in a named bag** with their spare clothes/items from the Kit List – **ALL named**, please. **Please also complete and sign the enclosed ‘Participant Registration Form’ and return it to school by Wednesday 19th May 2021 – thank you.**

The children will require a packed lunch and a drink of water (**no glass bottles please**) and they will return to school for 3.30 pm.

A voluntary contribution of £25.10 per child to help cover the cost of transport and activities would be gratefully received. This visit is now available on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way. As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay, you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the School Office.

As I am sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and, therefore, could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact me in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Should you wish your child to take part, please log onto ParentPay and give your consent/make payment by Wednesday 19th May 2021. Prompt payment appreciated, no exceptions for lateness.
