Year 6 – Visit to Hands on History Museum in Hull – Thursday 23rd May 2019

As part of the Year 6 'Ancient Egyptians' topic, the children will be visiting the Hands on History Museum in Hull on Thursday 23rd May 2019. During their visit the children will visit the Egyptian Gallery, home to a genuine 2,600 year old mummy and treasures from the tomb of Tutankhamun, and learn about making papyrus and mummification!

The children will be leaving school directly after registration at 9.00am and will travel by coach to the Museum. The children should wear school uniform and will require a packed lunch and a drink of water (no glass bottles please). The children will return to school before the end of the school day.

A voluntary contribution of £9.91 per child to help cover the cost of transport and activities would be gratefully received. This visit is now available on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way. As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the School Office.

As I am sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay.
