Dear Parent/Carer (Year 6)

Year 6 – Visit to ‘Let Loose’ in Woodmansey, Beverley – Wednesday 9th June 2021

Year 6 are planning to visit ‘Let Loose’ in Woodmansey for an exciting ‘Mega Guided Adventure Day’ on Wednesday 9th June. The day’s activities will include: a mixture of team games and challenges, high /low ropes, rope climb, roller skating, big leap & super slide and inflatables (weather permitting)!

The children will be leaving school directly after registration at 9.00 am and will travel by coach to ‘Let Loose’. They should wear comfortable clothes for outdoor activities, eg leggings/tracksuit bottoms, **long-sleeved** tops and trainers. No skirts or cropped tops. They will also need an anorak, or similar, to protect them from the rain. The high ropes can be chilly so layers with a sweatshirt/body warmer/hoodie would be good. The children will require a packed lunch and a drink of water (**no glass bottles please**). The children will return to school between 3.30 and 4.00 pm.

A voluntary contribution of £18.71 per child to help cover the cost of transport and activities would be gratefully received. This visit is now available on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way. As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay, you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the School Office.

As I am sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact me in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Should you wish your child to take part, please log onto ParentPay and give your consent/make payment by Wednesday 12th May 2021. Prompt payment appreciated; no exceptions for lateness.
