Year 1 – Visit to Hull Streetlife Museum – Monday 15th October 2018

On Monday 15th October, the Year 1 classes will be visiting the Streetlife Museum of Transport in Hull. The children will enjoy all the sights, sounds and smells of the past, stepping back in time with 200 years of transport history as they walk down a 1940s high street. They will also be taking part in a workshop where they will learn about toys that children would have played with in Victorian times.

The children will be back at school by 1.00 pm and will require a **PACKED LUNCH** to have on their return to school.

We offer the option of a **free packed lunch** on school trip days to those children who are eligible for Universal Infant Free School Meals (KS1). This is not compulsory, your child may bring their own packed lunch if you prefer. To ensure we are aware of all requests for packed lunches on the day, may we please request that **all parents complete and return the reply slip overleaf even if you do not require a school packed lunch and ensure that we receive it by Monday 1st October at the latest** – thank you.

A **voluntary contribution of £ 5.08 per child** would be gratefully received to cover the cost of transport and workshop. This visit is now available on the ParentPay website for you to pay/consent online in the usual way. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the school office. As we are sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Should you wish your child to take part, please log onto ParentPay and give your consent/make payment **by Monday 1st October.**

Finally, the Year 1 team would like some parent volunteers to accompany each class, so if you would like to join them please see one of the Year 1 class teachers.
