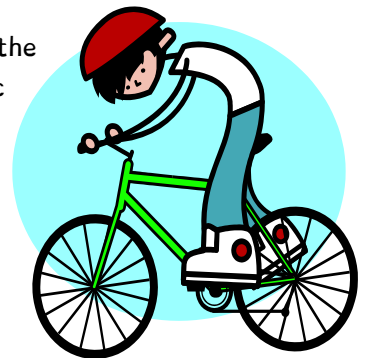
Year 5 – Practical Cycle Skills Training – £15.00 Payment Now Due

Thank you for completing a consent form for your child to take part in the two-day Practical Cycle Skills Training course run by the East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

We should be grateful if you would now make your payment of £15.00 online via ParentPay in the usual way by the deadline of Friday 1st February 2019.

This is a two-day practical course of instruction (8 hours in total) with the first two hours being conducted on the playground, incorporating a basic cycle check, with the following six hours conducted in a live, on road, environment.

The children will be taught in small groups over two days. **The training will take place between 7th and 20th May 2019.**



Please remember that:

- Your child will need to be able to ride a bicycle without wobbling and be able to ride one-handed for at least five seconds.
- As well as a bicycle, you will need to provide your child with a correctly fitting helmet and explain that they are expected to wear it.
- The bicycle your child uses for training will need to be mechanically roadworthy and of the correct size. A child should be able to touch the ground with both feet whilst sitting on the seat. The law requires that a bike has two working brakes.
