Year 5 – World War II Topic Non-Uniform Day – Tuesday 20th October 2020

On Tuesday 20th October 2020, the Year 5 children are invited to spend the school day **dressed as evacuees**. This will be part of the Year 5 World War II topic, as we look at how ordinary people at home were affected by the war. In an effort to be authentic, please keep the children's costumes simple, for example a plain blouse/shirt with plain skirt/trousers.

Your child will also be building a mini **Anderson Shelter** (A4 size). They will be decorating the shelter in context with the period. If you have any resources that they may use, please send them with your child on the day.

The children do not need to bring any of their usual equipment to school, so no bags, pencil cases, books etc needed. They can bring a small teddy, a small case or a gas mask box (small cardboard box) if they would like to, anything an evacuee may have travelled with.
